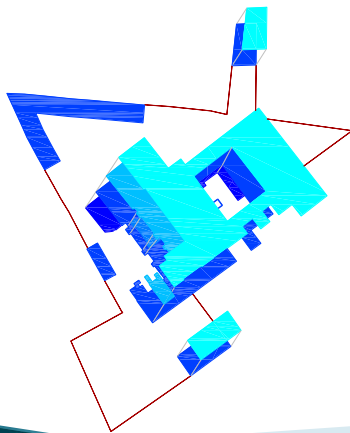


## Convento do Carmo Moura

The Convento do Carmo was the first monastery of the Order of the Carmelites founded in Portugal and in the Iberian Peninsula, in 1251. The church and the cloister are classified as Property of Public Interest, since 1944. This property is a remarkable heritage located in the historic center of Moura, a beautiful city in Alentejo near Évora and a few kilometers from Spain. Its location, near the Castle, allows establish visual relations with the Guadiana river, the Alqueva dam and with others stunning landscapes.
