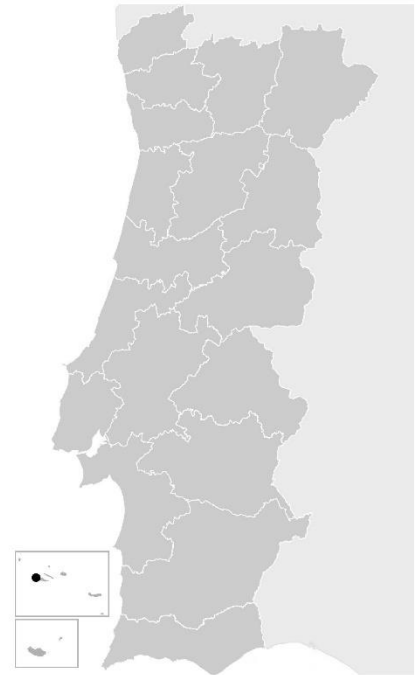
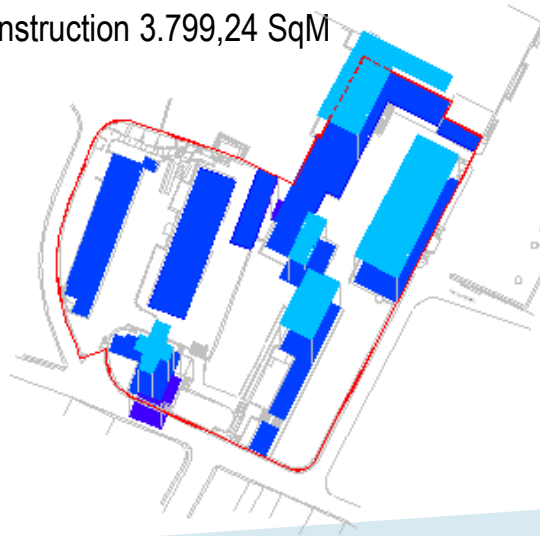


Quartel do Carmo – Horta Açores

Known as the “Quartel do Carmo”, this former convent is located on a plateau in the city of Horta, on the fantastic Faial island, where splendid views of the house and the harbor can be seen, with the ocean and the silhouette of Pico Island as horizon. His construction began in the 17th Century, in 1652, as a Convent of the Carmelite Order. In the twentieth century it was adapted to welcome the Horta Infantry Company. The ensemble in question is considered to be the first Carmelite expansion in the Portuguese islands, which remains to this day as an important Heritage of the Azores Archipelago.
