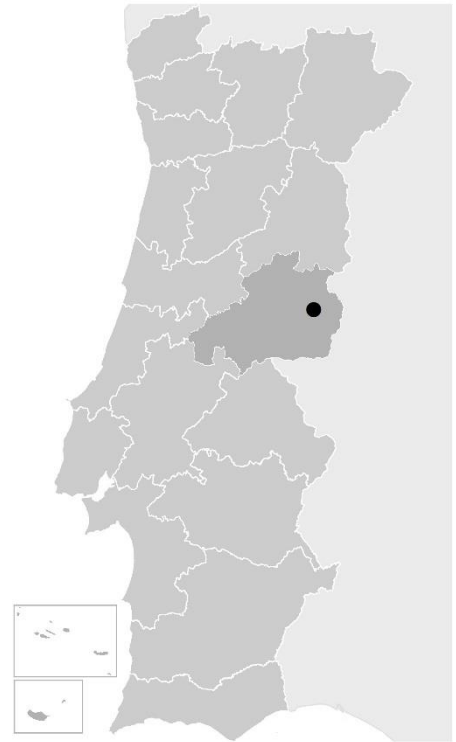

The Casa de Marrocos is located in Idanha-a-Velha, a small village (located on the banks of the Pônsul River) unique, beauty and antique. This property is near the Paleocristan Basilica and is part of the architectural and archaeological complex of Idanha-a-Velha, which is classified as a National Monument. Thus, this property, inserted in the Roman Villa that dates back to the 1st century B.C., is a place of great interest that attract numerous visitors. The Casa de Marrocos was built in an eclectic style with remarkable constructive details. It is worth noting the interior staircase of granite that runs along the three floors.
